Senior Picture Information:

We recommend that you have your senior portrait taken by a professional photography studio--they are knowledgeable about taking great senior photos!

If you choose not to use a professional photographer, you do so at your own risk. Please pay attention to the specifications listed below to ensure that we do not reject your photo. If you choose not to have your senior portrait taken at all, we will use your school photo as a default.

Senior photos are due in the main office on or before Friday, September 28th. Late photos may not be in the yearbook!

All photographs must meet the following yearbook requirements:

- All photos must be color. Black & white pictures will not be accepted.
- Senior must be centered in the photo facing the camera, both eyes visible.
- Pose must be a waist-up shot. No knees in frame. No hands near the face.
- Senior clothing and jewelry must fit school dress code guidelines and be "school appropriate".
- No soft focus. No vignettes. No photo effects.
- NO PROPS! (animals, hats, sunglasses, or additional people in photo).
- Background must be simple and uncluttered. Outdoors is preferable.
- No texture, name stamping, or embossing.
- All photos must be in a digital format, with a minimum of 300dpi resolution and saved as a JPG file.
- Photo files must be saved as the senior's last name and then first name., preferably on a CD.

If you cannot, for any reason, produce a photo that fits these requirements, please contact the Yearbook Adviser to see if there is anything the Yearbook Staff can do to help.

Senior Dedications

It is an old tradition for parents and family members to purchase space in the yearbook and fill it with pictures and words of congratulations to their graduating senior.

It is a new tradition for seniors to buy space for their friends. It's a fun opportunity to say goodbye to those special people who have made a difference or who will never be forgotten.
